Dr. **Bryan Ray** has worked as an editor at *Science* for over 20 years. He currently a Senior Editor at *Science* and was the Founding Editor of *Science Signaling*. Bryan was trained as an undergraduate at the University of California at Berkeley, and received his PhD from the University of Virginia. As a postdoc at UVa Tom Sturgill, Bryan discovered the widely studied enzyme known as "MAP kinase". Bryan handles papers on topics that include signal transduction, systems biology, protein and gene



networks, cell cycle, apoptosis, metabolism, circadian rhythms, and aging. When he's not marking papers with red ink, Bryan is an avid amateur photographer and Nikon fan.
